Plaintiff Enrique Hernandez is entitled to recover of the Defendant the sum of \$2,768.60, with interest thereon at the rate of ten percent per annum; and is further entitled to recover, on his award of \$2,268.60 for Defendant's violations of the FLSA and Defendant's breach of his employment contract, prejudgment interest at the rate of ten percent per annum from August 21, 2005 to the date of this judgment;

d. Plaintiff Maximiliano Hernandez is entitled to recover of the Defendant the sum of \$1,704.52, with interest thereon at the rate of ten percent per annum; and is further entitled to recover on this award for Defendant's violations of the FLSA and Defendant's breach of his employment contract, prejudgment interest at the rate of ten percent per annum from July 31, 2005 to the date of this judgment;

e. Plaintiff Blas Martinez is entitled to recover of the Defendant the sum of \$4,233.13, with interest thereon at the rate of ten percent per annum; and is further entitled to recover, on his award of \$3,733.13 for Defendant's violations of the FLSA and Defendant's breach of his employment contract, prejudgment interest at the rate of ten percent per annum from August 21, 2005 to the date of this judgment;

f. Plaintiff Joaquin Martinez Jimenez is entitled to recover of the Defendant the sum of \$12,496.20, with interest thereon at the rate of ten percent per annum; and is further entitled to recover, on his award of \$11,326.20 for Defendant's violations of the FLSA and Defendant's breach of his employment contract, prejudgment interest at the rate of ten percent per annum from September 11, 2005 to the date of this judgment;

g. Plaintiff Jose Rene Santamaria Arriaga is entitled to recover of the Defendant the sum of \$2,700.40, with interest thereon at the rate of ten percent per annum; and is further entitled to recover on this award for Defendant's violations of the FLSA and Defendant's breach of his employment contract, prejudgment interest at the rate of ten percent per annum from July 31, 2005 to the date of this judgment;

h. Plaintiff Elder Mejia is entitled to recover of the Defendant the sum of \$2,045.40, with interest thereon at the rate of ten percent per annum; and is further entitled to recover on this award for Defendant's violations of the FLSA and Defendant's breach of his employment contract, prejudgment interest at the rate of ten percent per annum from July 31, 2005 to the date of this judgment;

i. Plaintiff Nerbin Rodriguez Mancian is entitled to recover of the Defendant the sum of \$4,762.28, with interest thereon at the rate of ten percent per annum; and is further entitled to recover, on his award of \$4,262.28 for Defendant's violations of the FLSA and Defendant's breach of his employment contract, prejudgment interest at the rate of ten percent per annum from July 31, 2005 to the date of this judgment;

j. Plaintiff Jose Ulloa is entitled to recover of the Defendant the sum of \$1,704.52, with interest thereon at the rate of ten percent per annum; and is further entitled to recover on this award for Defendant's violations of the FLSA and Defendant's breach of his employment contract, prejudgment interest at the rate of ten percent per annum from July 31, 2005 to the date of this judgment; and

k. Plaintiff Felipe Vicente Urbano is entitled to recover of the Defendant the sum of \$1,152.26, with interest thereon at the rate of ten percent per annum; and is further entitled to recover on this award for Defendant's violations of the FLSA and Defendant's breach of his employment contract,

prejudgment interest at the rate of ten percent per annum from July 31, 2005 to the date of this judgment.

3. ALL REMAINING CLAIMS ARE DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
